Exposure: South, South-West

Soils: rich in clay and limestone skeleton components

Grapes: Corvina, Merlot and other local grapes.

Description and characteristics:

Pale pink is the delicate shade of our SenzaFine Rosato, obtained from Corvina, Merlot and a small percentage of local grapes. Inviting are the delicate fragrance of raspberries and roses bloom and its freshness, with good balance between alcohol and residual sugar, on the palate. The pleasant acidity and its good presence in the aftertaste accompanies very well dishes with fish, pasta creations with strong sauces and simmered veal or poultry dishes.
